6.3. REPORT FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER FOR THE LA PUENTE VALLEY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT REGARDING THE INDUSTRY PUBLIC UTILITIES WATER OPERATIONS

RECOMMENDED ACTION: *Receive and file the Report.*

Roy Frausto, General Manager of the La Puente Valley County Water District, provided a staff report and updated the Commission on the settlement for per-and polyfluoroalkyl substances ("PFAS") contaminants in water supply wells affecting the City's Waterworks System (CIWS). Of the two-class action lawsuits, one with 3M and the other with DuPont, 3M has awarded CIWS 1.192 million dollars. The first installment of close to \$200,000.00 will be distributed within 3 weeks. The remainder of the funds will be distributed by Q2 of 2033. Commissioner Ruggles asked if these funds were limited or would it go to the general fund? Roy Frausto replied that there are no restrictions, and it is up to the City as to how to hold the money but essentially it is intended for repairs. The DuPont settlement is still pending.
